Phonics

Children in **Nursery** will continue to build on their knowledge of rhyme and will be encouraged to invent their own. Children will continue to explore alliteration , oral segmenting and blending of CVC words.

Children will continue to explore initial sounds in their name and other objects that might share it.

Children in **Reception** will continue to apply the sounds they have learnt to orally segment and blend words for reading and writing. Children will continue to learn to read simple captions and build on their knowledge of 'Tricky Words'. Children will also build up strategies to support their reading such as checking for meaning, using the context to support understanding and making predictions etc.

It is very important that your child gets as many opportunities to apply their knowledge of the letters and sounds through reading and writing. Please make sure you support your child to read the small reading books sent home twice a week.

Nursery Topic

This term Nursery will be learning all about '**Under the Sea**'.

Our main books for this term will be 'Sharing a Shell', 'Rainbow Fish' and 'The Fish Who Could Wish.'

We will be exploring story structures and children will be encouraged to make up their own stories and alternative endings to familiar ones.



In maths children will continue to build on their knowledge of numbers focusing on identifying and ordering numbers from 0-10

Reception Topic

This term Reception will be learning all about '**Traditional Tales**'. We will be reading familiar fairy tales such as: The Three Little Pigs, The Billy Goats Gruff, Little Red Riding Hood and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We will be making up our own fairy tales too!

In maths we will be ordering numbers from 1-20, recalling what is one more and one less and completing simple addition and subtraction calculations.

This half term children will continue to visit local parks to explore ponds.

This half term Reception will be going to Kentish Town Farm to see some of the animals found in the traditional tales we will be reading as well as other farm animals.
