




# Curriculum News

## Summer 2 - Year 3

### English:

This term we will be starting by writing narratives, using the stories 'Weslandia' and 'The BFG' as inspiration. We will be continuing to develop our sentence structures, through using different starters (adverbs, verbs, prepositions) as well as extending our sentences through a variety of conjunctions (until, despite, though, whilst, however, during).



### Maths:

Having almost completed the Year 3 curriculum, we will be focusing on statistics and geometry to begin with.

Afterwards we will be re-viewing our learning throughout the year so that the children are secure and confident moving up to Year 4.



### Reading:

The children have a guided reading session with the teacher or teaching assistant at least twice a week.

On the days the children are not reading with the teacher they will be completing reading related activities or practising reading with another adult.

All children are expected to read **daily** with an adult at home.

**Science:** We will be beginning to focus on gardens, developing our Year 3 flower beds in the KS2 playgrounds. Please ask us about our progress as we love to share! Alongside this we are continuing to learn about Light and Shadows.

In **P.E** Erion will be developing our Athletics skills. P.E will be on **Thursday mornings** and **Friday afternoons**. Please ensure your child brings in their PE kit. This should consist of a loose white t-shirt and loose jogging bottoms or leggings. **Children should not come to school in their PE kit.**

**SEAL/PSHCE:** This term we will be focusing on **Changes**. This will include how to support each other with the changes that are happening around us.

**Computing:** This term we are going to cover e-safety and the uses technology has within our world.
